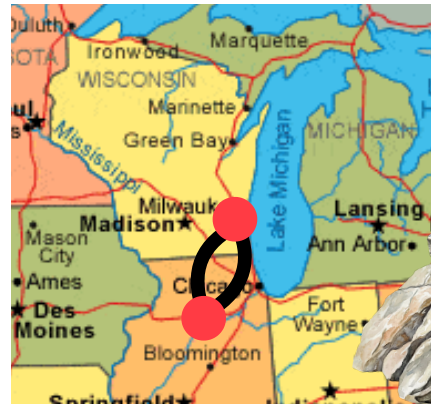
STARVED ROCK

Starved Rock State Park is situated along the south bank of the Illinois River. The charm of Starved Rock lies largely in the fact that everything is in a state of nature just as it was when Joliet and Marquette were there many years ago. Discover breathtaking sandstone canyons, scenic river views, and picturesque trails as you explore one of the Midwest's most beloved natural treasures. Whether you're taking in the peaceful landscapes, learning about the area's rich history, or simply unwinding in the cozy lodge atmosphere, this tour offers the perfect blend of nature, comfort, and adventure. What a lovely fall getaway!

Tuesday, Sep. 15 - We are off on our two-day adventure to Illinois' **Starved Rock State Park**. Upon arrival we are treated to a delicious lunch and the **"Nashville Connection"** show featuring the sounds of Country Music. Dave & Daphne will delight us with this high-energy classic country and gospel performance. The duo is known for their extensive touring across the US, especially in Nashville. Enjoy such hits as "Hey Good Lookin'" "Kiss An Angel" "Stand By Your Man" and many more. Late afternoon finds us venturing off on a scenic guided walk to **Council Overhang and Ottawa Canyon**. Wednesday, Sep. 16 - After a delightful hot breakfast buffet, we board the **Eagle 1 pontoon boat** for a picturesque cruise on the Illinois River. Later we board an authentic trolley for a **tour of the Starved Rock area**. Learn about the rich history of Starved Rock State Park, a National Historic Landmark. Explore the park's visitor center and the **Illinois Waterway Lock & Dam** and Visitor Center. Tour the historic downtown area of Utica. A wonderful lunch awaits us in the lodge dining room. After lunch we enjoy a walking tour of the **Starved Rock Lodge**. We are informed about this unique structure built in the 1930's by Civil Conservation Corps. We'll see the thoughtful touches of the stone masons and the modern amenities which seamlessly blend with yesteryear. After lunch and our tour we make our way home. **(B, L)**
